Today I want to show you my new work and share a pattern for it.

I knitted this cardigan for a 5 years old girl. As a basis, I use the free pattern Cotton-Ease Eyelet Yoke Cardigan (click the link). However, I made changes - I knitted from top to bottom, starting with the yoke, and made the back and fronts without seams. In that pattern, two fronts and a back are knitted in separate parts, sleeves are knitted in rows, then all the necessary seams are made, and only after that everything is joined and a round yoke is knitted.



YARN

Red Heart Super Saver Ombre

- JAZZY Color
- 283 g 440 m
- 100% acrylic
- Number of skeins: 1 (256 g)


Knitting needles: 3.5 mm

GAUGE

Stockinette stitch


- 16 sts in 10 cm, 1.6 st in 1 cm.
- 8 rows in 3 cm, 2.67 rows in 1 cm.

Measurements



- Chest 57 cm
- The length from the armhole 23.5 cm
- Yoke height 16.5 cm
- Sleeve length from armhole 31
 cm
- I used calculations for the yoke from <u>the pattern</u> for 4 yo size

Let's start knitting



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I - Knit


— - Purl

O - Yarn Over

\bigstar - K2tog
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YOKE

- 1. Cast on <u>73 stitches</u>.
- 2. Knit a Yoke according to the pattern. Along the edges make a band with Seed stitch pattern (4 stitches).
 - **Rows 1-3**: Seed st.
 - Row 4 (Buttonhole Row): K1, P1, yo,
 K2tog, work in Seed st to end of the row.
 - Row 5: work in Seed st.
 - Row 6: Keeping first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, Knit increase 7 sts evenly spaced across row - <u>80 sts.</u>



Seed Stitch Pattern

| - Knit _ - Purl

- Row 7: Working first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, purl.
- Row 8 (Inc Row): Work 4 sts in Seed st, *K2, increase *, work last 4 sts in Seed st - <u>116 sts.</u>
- Row 9: Working first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, knit.
- Row 10: Working first 4 sts in Seed st,
 k2tog, yo to last 4 sts, work last 4 sts
 in Seed st.
- Rows 11-12: Working first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, knit.
- Rows 13-14: Keeping first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, work in St. st.

- Row 15: Working first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, knit.
- Row 16: Working first 4 sts in Seed st,
 k2tog, yo to last 4 sts, work last 4 sts in Seed st.
- Row 17: Working first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, knit.
- Row 18: Working first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, knit.
- Row 19: Working first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, purl.
- Row 20: Work 4 sts in Seed st, *K2, increase
 *, work last 4 sts in Seed st <u>152 sts.</u>
- Rows 21-24: Rep Rows 15-18.

- Rows 25-26: Keeping first and last 4
 sts in Seed st as established, work in
 St. st. In the Row 25 make a buttonhole
 (K1, P1, yo, K2tog).
- Rows 27-30: Rep Rows 15-18.
- Row 31: Working first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, purl.
- Row 32: Work 4 sts in Seed st, *K4, increase *, work last 4 sts in Seed st 188 sts.
- Row 33-36: Rep Rows 15-18.
- Rows 37-38: Keeping first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, work in St. st.

- **Rows 39-42**: Rep Rows 15-18.
- Rows 43-44: Keeping first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, work in St. st.
- Row 45: Working first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, purl.
- Row 46: Keeping first and last 4 sts in Seed st as established, Knit increasing 7 sts evenly spaced across row - <u>195 sts.</u>

Separate the body and sleeves





- 53 sts (back) + 30 sts (front) + 30 sts (front) +
 41 st s (sleeve) + 41 sts (sleeve) = 195 sts.
- Remove sts for sleeves on an additional thread.
- Work 4 rows in stocking stitch on the back (53 sts) for neck shaping.
- Next, join fronts and back (make 6 sts between fronts and back for the armhole).
- Work the body in a Stockinette st, make buttonholes every 23 rows (the 1st, 24th, 47th rows, 5 buttons in total). Work 58 rows in total, then bind off.

Sleeves



- Slip the stitches from the additional thread to the knitting needles, join to the round and work in Stockinette st, making decreases in each 4th row 13 times (up to 52 rows - 58 ->32 sts).
- Next, work according to the pattern:

53 row: Knit

54 row: Purl

55 row: *K2tog, yo*

56 row: Purl

57-69 rows: Knit

70-74 rows: Work in Seed st

Bind off.
